## BEHAVIOR PREVIEW

## WHAT IS IT?

Prime or precorrect behavior skills necessary for learning and growth

- Remind students of a behavior of focus for the activity
- 90-s preview (description and model) of expected behaviors
- Have groups of student brainstorm examples and nonexamples of expected behaviors – provide feedback




# BEHAVIOR REVIEW

## WHAT IS IT?

Reflection and feedback on behavior that leads to continuous improvement

- After an activity, students spend 90-s reviewing appropriate and inappropriate behaviors observed during the activity
- Briefly discuss student examples and provide feedback



## MULTICLASS MEETING

#### WHAT IS IT?

Staff and students learn from colleagues and peers

- Can be a preview of expectations or review of student behavior
- Multiple classrooms, entire grade levels, or whole school
- Shows consistency of behavior expectations across staff
