


Course Instructions

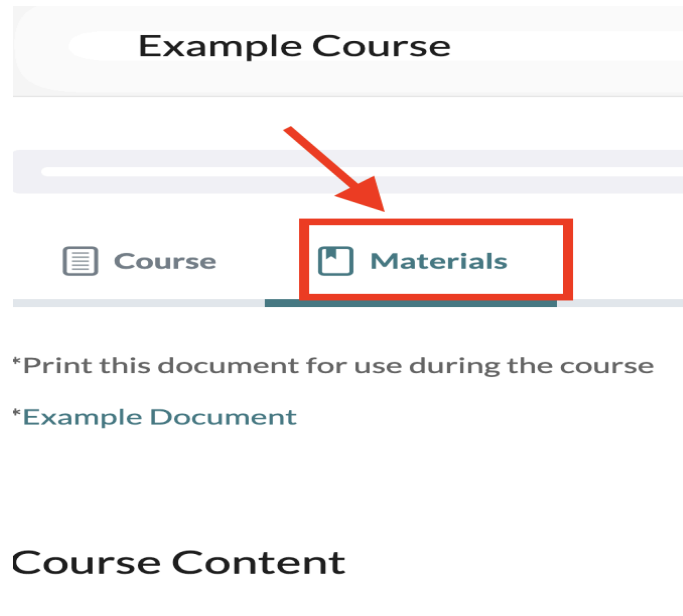

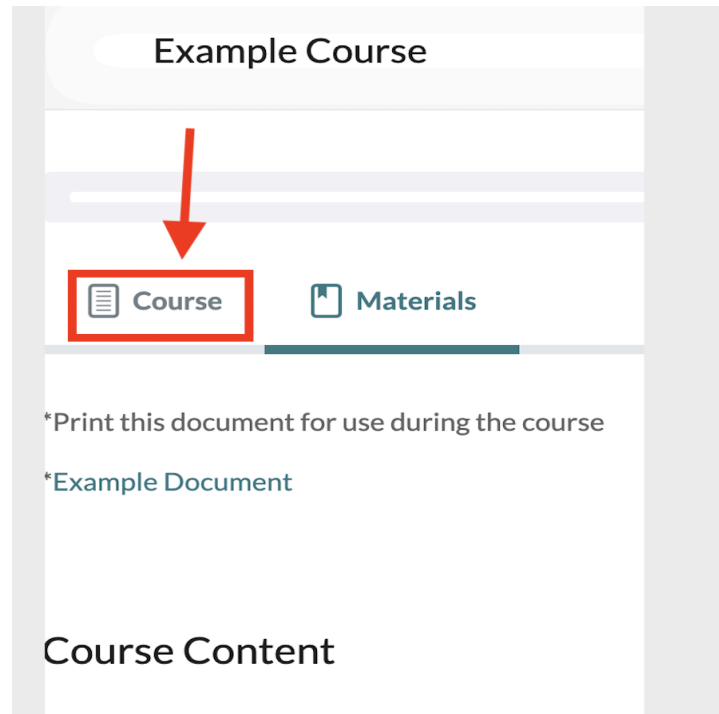
Step 5:

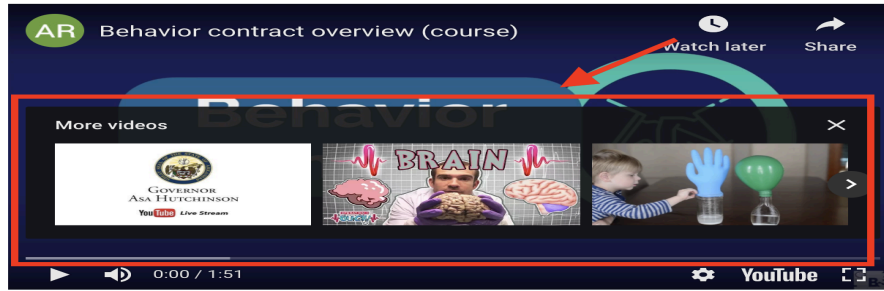
- Some topics will include videos. You must watch these videos in their entirety. You will not have access to fast-forward or rewind the video.

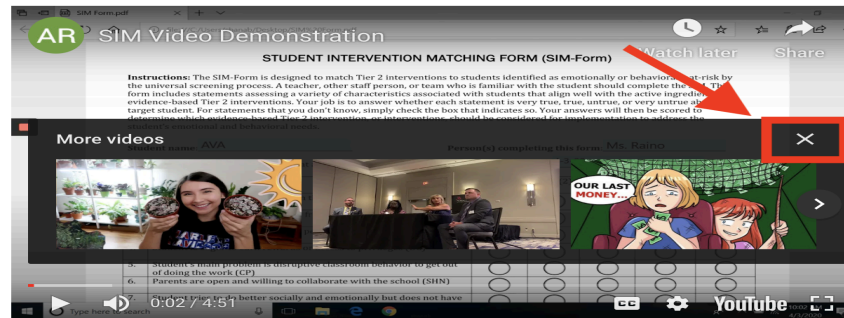


- You do not have to click on or watch videos that may pop up as options when a video embedded in the course is paused or completed.

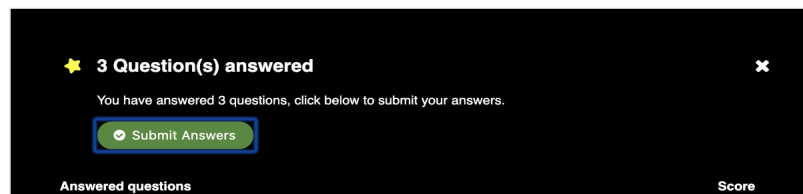




- Click the “x” in the right-hand corner to remove the pop-up video options



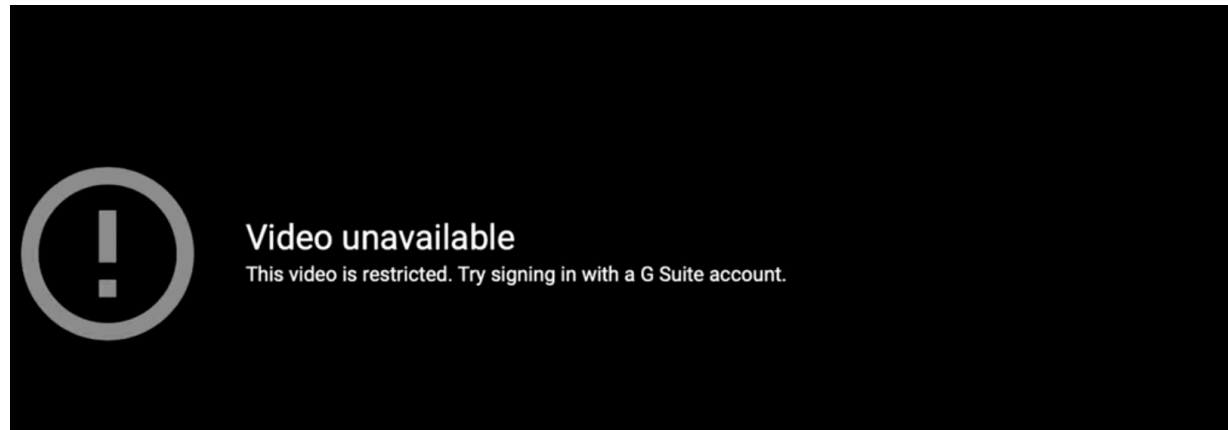
- When you complete an interactive video, you must click “submit answers” in order to select the “Start Quiz” button below the video.
